Mr. d'Aquino will focus on the opportunities for environmental leadership, the need for policy cohesion in Canada and globally in dealing with climate change, and the opportunity to harness technology to produce superior economic and environmental performance.

Mr. d'Aquino is Co-Chair of the CCCE's Task Force on Environmental Leadership. His fellow Co-Chairs are Dick Evans, Chief Executive, Rio Tinto Alcan, and Rick George, President and Chief Executive Officer, Suncor Energy Inc. The CCCE Task Force, composed of thirty-three chief executives of leading companies with a major stake in environmental and energy issues, produced a highly acclaimed report last October calling for Canadian leadership on environmental issues as a centerpiece of Canada's quest for global competitiveness.
