"CO2 Pipeline Infrastructure"

Calgary, AB – This luncheon presentation will examine the strategic drivers that are likely to create a carbon dioxide transportation and sequestration network in Alberta. It will then discuss the issues, the costs and the timing of a carbon dioxide pipeline network. Efforts to develop integrated carbon sequestration facilities will be examined. Finally, an innovative approach to developing additional "useful work" for carbon dioxide through the use of Slurry pipelines will be explored.

About the speaker:

Chuck is currently responsible for evaluating and developing investment opportunities in new growth platforms. These include windpower, gas-fired generation, fuel cells, heavy oil upgrading, carbon dioxide sequestration and other emerging energy technologies. He is also President of Enbridge Wind Energy Inc. and oversees the Enbridge interest in wind power operations.

Prior to his current assignment, Chuck was VP Planning & Business Development where he directed the Enbridge Strategic Planning process, the Corporate Economic Evaluation group and the Pathfinders effort. Chuck is on the Advisory Board of the University of Alberta's Centre for Applied Business Research in Energy and the Environment and the Board of Petroleum Technology Alliance Canada.
